

BINGO SPEAKING ASSESSMENT

On the back you will find a Bingo “game.” Each square contains material from Spanish I. You may choose what items to answer, but you must answer each item in complete Spanish sentences! For each square you complete, you will be given a stamp. The goal is to get as many ‘Bingos’ as you can. You will be given a minimal amount of class time to work on this assignment, but you can arrange to come for help before or after school if needed. The due date is Friday September 25th at 2pm (B day, you must turn in during class on the 24th or come to the room on the 25th to turn in your paper). Plan accordingly.

You **MAY**:

- go to any Spanish teacher at AK to complete a square (however, do not interrupt class!)
- practice your squares outside of class and/or review notes
- come to class before or after school to get help or complete squares

You may **NOT**:

- write out your answers and read from the paper
- do more than 3 squares in one day

The game is worth 80 points:

Cover all= 80 points (100%)

5 Bingos= 75 points (94%)

4 Bingos= 70 points (88%)

3 Bingos= 66 points (83%)

2 Bingos= 60 points (75%)

1 Bingo= 56 points (70%)

atOdds and ends that do not equal a Bingo= 48 points (60%)

Introduce yourself, state your phone number, and where you are from. Ask me how I am feeling.	State what your favorite class is, who the teacher is, what time it starts, and why it is your favorite class.	Describe what you would eat for a typical lunch. List a minimum of 3 foods and 1 beverage.	Say what you are going to do this weekend. Ask your teacher what she is going to do this weekend.	State the Spanish alphabet. Count to 20 in Spanish.
State the members of your immediate family and how they are related to you. State their ages.	State at least three phrases that you will hear in Spanish class a lot this year.	Describe how you are feeling today and why.	State three things that you like to do after school. Ask me what I like to do after school.	Name three different places in the school and at least one activity that is done in each place.
Describe what you would eat for a typical breakfast. List a minimum of 3 foods and 1 beverage.	State the days of the week and the months of the year. Which ones are your favorites?	Describe your favorite athlete, musician, actor, etc. without saying his or her name to your teacher. 2 stamps if she can guess who you are describing!	Describe one member of your family's physical appearance and personality. Use at least 4 adjectives.	State your birth date. Then ask me when my birthday is.
State three different activities you do on the weekend and how often you do each activity.	Describe your best friend's physical appearance and their personality. Use at least 4 different adjectives.	Introduce another member of the class. State their name, how old they are, and where they are from.	State five articles of clothing that you are currently wearing and its color.	Name three different classes on your schedule and state what time each starts.
State your favorite season and describe the weather in that season. Also, state the months that are in that season.	State where you live and describe its location.	State the different school supplies you need for three classes on your schedule.	Describe what you would eat for a typical dinner. List a minimum of 3 foods and 1 beverage.	State an activity that your best friend likes to do. Then state whether you like/dislike this activity.
